Children's Subject: Don't Listen to People Who Say Bad Things

"Whose mouths must be stopped, who subvert whole houses, teaching things which they ought not, for filthy lucre's sake" (Titus 1:11).

"Put it in the Trash Can and Put Your Foot on It." →

Create small sheets of paper. Some with the words Love, Peace, Joy, Happiness, and other good words. On other pieces, put words that are not good, such as hate, mean, not nice, disobedient, troublemaker.

Put the words in a bag. Have the children pull out each one. If it is a good word, have someone explain what it is. If it's a bad word, put it in a trash can, or crumble it up and step on it. Then put it in the trash can.

The Lesson:

Long ago, a man named Titus was on a big island teaching families about Jesus. But some sneaky people came along and started spreading bad lies about God!

They did not love Jesus—they just wanted attention and money. They confused whole families and made a giant mess.

Sometimes people use their mouths to say things that are not true or helpful. They might try to tell you bad things about the House of Prayer.

The House of Prayer is the Word of God. Daddy Cunningham is a servant of God.

Keep your hearts full of the good things we learn in Sunday School!
